

## RATES AND INDEXING OF DUES, RENTS, ROYALTIES AND FEES: JANUARY 1, 2020

# NOTICE

Pursuant to section 83.3 of the *Financial Administration Act* (CQLR, chapter A-6.001), these fees are indexed automatically every year on January 1st to reflect the annual change in the Consumer Price Index for Québec. The indexation factor for this year is set at 1.72%\*. In accordance with section 83.6 of the *Financial Administration Act*, the Ministry of Energy and Natural Resources hereby publishes the 2020 indexation for fees set under the *Regulation respecting mineral substances other than petroleum, natural gas and brin* (CQLR, chapter M-13.1, r. 2).

Accordingly, the fees as from January 1, 2020, are as shown below.
