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## INTRODUCTION

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Depuis 1953, des travaux de recherche sur la biologie du Saumon de l'Atlantique ont été poursuivis par la Station de Biologie marine de Grande Rivière. En 1958, nous avons collaboré à ces travaux et c'est à partir de cette date que nous avons commencé à préparer une liste aussi complète que possible des travaux scientifiques concernant la biologie générale de cette espèce.

Nous présentons ici cette liste en espérant qu'elle sera utile à tous les chercheurs des différents pays où le Saumon présente encore un certain intérêt dans l'économie des pêches tant sportives que commerciales.

Pour réaliser ce travail, nous avons consulté les grands ouvrages suivants:
