Canada Post: Possible Strike

Depending on the negotiations currently underway with a view to renewing its employees' collective agreement, Canada Post may interrupt its activities from July 2, 2016, onwards.

As a preventive measure, beginning on June 28, 2016, the Ministère de l'Énergie et des Ressources naturelles (MERN) is taking the following steps to ensure that its notices and decisions are sent to the holders of mining rights:

Registration certificates, acknowledgements of receipt, notices, letters, contracts, decisions and draft decisions will all be e-mailed to the holders of mining rights, using the email addresses already in the MERN's files. Where applicable, any time periods stipulated by law will begin when the documents in question are received at the email addresses concerned.

The MERN will contact holders who have not yet provided an email address, in order to obtain one.

Obligation of holders of mining rights

The holders of mining rights must take the steps required to ensure that they fulfill their obligations within the timeframes stipulated by the Mining Act and its regulations, among other things by considering different options for the submission of documents and payments to the MERN, including the possibility of using a private mail delivery service.
